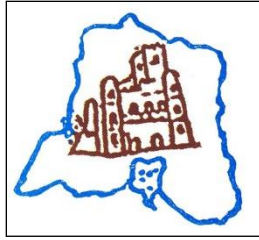

1. Introduction

Gonder Relief, Rehabilitation and Development Association, GRRDA, is a membership organization which is non-political, non-religious and non-profit making established in 1992 by interested individuals of natives of Gonder. The objective of the association is to contribute to the efforts in the eradication of poverty and promote the socio-economic development of the people of Gonder covering the former North and South Gonder administrative zones. GRRDA, is registered by the Agency for Civil Society Organizations based on the new Proclamation No.1113/2019.

The vision of GRRDA is to see the people of Gonder free from poverty and enjoy decent life and its mission is to bring sustainable change to the people in North and South Gonder zones through implementing programs focusing on education, health, water and sanitation, employment creation and natural resources preservation,

GRRDA has been implementing projects in partnership with organization having common goals and stakeholders' participation. In its course of life, GRRDA has implemented projects that include

school expansion and improving school standards, fulfilling school materials; building clinics and improving health facilities with health equipment support which made the services accessible to target communities.

GRRDA also intervenes in emergencies when they occur in its operational area. In the reporting year, as the result of the conflict between “ Qemant and Amhara” in West and Central Gonder zones over 60,000 people were displaced. GRRDA designed a lifesaving project and was financed by International Rescue Committee (IRC). Through this fund GRRDA has implemented a WASH project for internally displaced people (IDPs) with the objective of saving lives that were threatened due to lack of clean water and other non- food items that support the people to ensure their survival. GRRDA was implementing the WASH project in three sites –Aykel, Ayimba and Arbaba in Central Gonder Zone. Water trucking and supply of non-food items that include supply of water tankers for group use at IDP sites, provision of jerricans and hygiene and sanitation materials such as soaps for individuals as well as increasing awareness of IDPs on hygiene and sanitation. Moreover, the project has constructed communal latrines in Arbaba and Aykel IDP sites. GRRDA was shuttling 25,000 liters of water daily from Gonder town to two IDP sites in Ayimba and Arbaba. The project has benefited more than 22,000 IDPs.

In a bid to contribute its share of responsibility to support conflict affected people sheltered in IDP sites in Central Gonder zones, GRRDA mobilized its members and supports and raised about Birr 262,000. Out of this Birr 212, 000 was donated to the coordinating government body to use it for reconstruction of houses and for purchase of household materials for returnees which was the dire need expressed by the Central Gonder zone administration. Birr 50,000 was used to support people displaced from other regions of the country and sheltered in Debre Tabor town. The fund was used for purchase of food items for 154 family members to bridge the rainy season.

The core program that GRRDA is embarking on is the scholarship project for preparatory school students. This project has been going on since 1996. The project is ran in partnership with GDCO in terms of funding and related technical support. The project aims at supporting students at preparatory level (11th and 12th grade) to enable them to continue their education so that they are able to move on to the next higher level i.e. college.

GRRDA mobilizes members to support in various ways that include financial contributions as well as technical expertise voluntarily.

In line to that, in addition to the preparatory level scholarship program, GRRDA through mobilizing fund at local level has extended its scholarship support for university students who passed the school leaving exam of 12th grade since 2016. Students who were getting the support at the preparatory level, who passed the exam and placed at the different government universities are offered the support. Every year 100 students (60 from North Gonder and 40 from South Gonder zones) were offered the opportunity. Thus, in the reporting period 300 students were planned to be supported from first to third year university students spread in over all government universities.

This report covers the physical activities accomplished and the corresponding financial performance in the reporting year of 2018/2019 (2011E.C.). The report also contains the list of students supported from each target school.

2. Objectives of the project

2.1. General objective

The general objective of the scholarship project is to enable high achiever students who do not get adequate support from their families to complete their preparatory education and pursue higher education to become fulfilled citizen.

2.2. Specific objectives

- To provide financial support for 270 selected preparatory level students for two years (11 & 12 grade students)
- To encourage others to compete and aspire to achieve higher grades in their education.
- To reduce the burden of family members of students to fulfill their children's education expenses.

3. Details of the program Beneficiaries of the program

The program is implemented in partnership with zonal education departments and schools. In the two zones (North and South Gonder) there are 45 preparatory schools covered by the project; 27 in North and 18 in South Gonder zone. Six students are selected from each school for the program. The selection criteria includes the following:

- High academic performance of students,
- Not getting adequate financial support from families,
- Good conduct and free from addiction of any type.

A committee is formed from each school and the committee selects students eligible for the scholarship award. The Committee is composed of the following:

- The school director 1
- Parents representatives 2
- Teachers representatives 2
- Students representatives 2

At the beginning of every academic year, GRRDA sends a request with templates to Education Departments of the two zones to send the selected students so that the process is finalized ahead of time. The Education Departments sent same request to preparatory schools. Each School committee selects eligible students for the scholarship opportunity based on the criteria set and record in the minute which every member should sign. Then the School directors send the names to the Education Departments with covering letter. Each Education Department compiles and sends it to GRRDA with covering letter which is duly signed and stamped.

This is highly process oriented system. This is done deliberately to ensure that the real target students are selected as well as to ward off any complaints of community members, parents and students. Moreover, it is to make the process more transparent and make sure that everybody along the line are responsible and owns the project.

4. Implementation strategy

GRRDA had employed a set of strategies to implement the scholarship project. Among others the following strategies are adapted:

- Partnership: there are a number of partners that are pertinent for the success of the project. GRRDA is working in partnership with GDCO and Zonal Education offices. GDCO is providing fund and technical advice in the implementation of the project while the partnership with the government supports on facilitation of the selection of students and supporting the overall process.
- Stakeholders' participation: stakeholders that include parents, school administration, teachers and students participate in the process of project implementation.
- Voluntary technical group: GRRDA uses experts to give service in pro-bono. A technical group is formed to provide support in project development and refining proposals as well as following up project implementation. These volunteers are highly experienced in the wider fields that give their support.
- Mobilizing members and supporters of GRRDA: GRRDA has been raising awareness of members on annual meetings and other gatherings to inform members on the progress of the project and the result of the project in supporting students. By so doing GRRDA mobilizes fund for the project.
- Ensure that all scholarship beneficiaries have a bank account in their name and a telephone address.

5. Accomplished activities

5.1. The process:

In the reporting year 2018/2019 (2011 E.C.), GRRDA has implemented the scholarship project as planned. The following activities were implemented:

- Selection of beneficiary students at preparatory level were completed. Six students from each school were selected from 45 schools (27 from North Gonder and 18 from South Gonder zone) following the criteria set.
- 270 students (41%female); 162 from North Gonder and 105 from South Gonder zones were selected by the committee set in each school.
- Official letter containing the list of scholarship beneficiaries with supporting documents that comprised signed minutes of school committee members were collected from the Education Departments of the two zones and submitted to GRRDA zonal offices.
- Every student data were collected including their profile with their photos and bank account.
- The payment for students was effected through bank account every semester after ensuring that the students have attended school in the semester through telephone calls of school directors.

5.2 Payments made for scholarship beneficiaries

5.2.1 North Gonder zone

Accomplishment

a) Preparatory School Students scholarship program

Out of the total 162 selected students, in the reporting school year 144 students have completed the academic year without interruption. But due to the conflict erupted in Central and West Gonder zones, schools were closed thus, 12 students didn't get the support for the last semester and 6 students of Beyeda Woreda didn't get the support for the last semester due to communication problem. There is no bank in the woreda and sending the support for the last semester was not possible. Thus in total 18 students were not supported for the last five months.

- The amount paid for these students is $144 \times \text{Birr } 200 \times 10 \text{ months} = \text{Birr } 288,000$.
- 18 students were paid for the first five month for the first semester which amounted to Birr 18,000
- Total paid for students in the reporting period was Birr 306,000.

b) University Students scholarship program

In North Gonder the scholarship activity for university students who benefited from the program were as follows:

Over all 33 university students (18.3%) entitled for the program at the three levels didn't attend their studies due to various reasons. Some withdrew and some could not submit their semester grade report on time.

5.2.2 South Gonder zone

a) Preparatory school students

In South Gonder zone, the scholarship program beneficiaries were drawn from 18 preparatory schools and 105 students were selected in the reporting year. Each student was supported with Birr 200 per month for ten months (one school year) which made the annual support Birr 2000 per student per annum. The total amount paid for all students was Birr 210,000. As the manager of GRRDA Debre Tabor office had left the organization suddenly during the beginning of the school year, all payment was made on the last semester after the recruitment of the new manager.

6. Testimonies of former scholarship awardees

Since the start of the scholarship program, thousands of citizens are benefited in terms of meeting their objective of achieving higher level studies. There are citizens who have become successful and have reached to the higher level of professional ladder. Many of them are serving their country in different capacities employed in government and corporate private organizations. There are citizens who passed through the program and have assumed leadership roles in the country. In the future, GRRDA will document sample of scholarship awardee at different professional fields and share with stakeholders to indicate their social and professional status as well as to have an overview of those who got the support.

Though it is not exhaustive, in this reporting period, sample of testimonies of people who passed through the process are presented for demonstration purposes.

- 1. Dejene (name changed for privacy reasons) was a member of the family of five. He grew up in Addis Zemen Woreda . He was one of the scholarship awardees of GRRDA-GDCO scholarship program in 2005 (1997 E.C.). He got the grant for two years when he was 11th & 12th grade student and was supported Birr 1500 (750 annual). Dejene said “ I was happy when I received the grant amount. This amount was huge for me as a student from marginal family. He further said the money was very useful to cover expenses for critical needs”. Dejen, gave the money to his father so that he can manage on his behalf. The father bought two sheep, a male and a female for breeding and in speculation for future use. The number of sheep increased to five after one year. Dejene, passed the National Examination and enrolled in Addis Abeba University. Dejene said his transportation to and from the university and his annual financial needs were covered from the sale of couple of sheep every year. Dejene graduated in Pharmacy; then he studied his MSC and other further studies. Now he is a senior researcher and a lecturer in epidemiology. He has established a family has two children. Dejene, emphasized that the financial support was very essential and timely for him to continue his study without frustration that would have caused due to lack of support to cover expenses for the basic needs in preparatory schools as well as in college. He now is committed to payback being member of GRRDA and contribute his share of responsibility in terms of supporting others.*
- 2. Bamlaku (name changed) was born in a family of six and grew up in Belessa woreda in N. Gonder zone. Bamlaku was an outstanding student in his education and was awarded a scholarship of the scheme of GRRD and GDCO when he was at 11th grade in 1995 E.C. He was supported for two years Birr 75 per month. He passed the National Exam and studied medicine in Gomder University and graduated in doctor of medicine. After graduation he was assigned in a rural health center and served for five years. Now he is discharging his professional responsibility in one of the big hospitals in Addis Abeba. He is also striving to work his post-doctoral degree which he will realize it soon. Bamlaku said he used the money he got from the award very wisely. He gave the money he received from the scholarship award to his mother for income generation activities. He said as they were living in the rural, his mother started trading agricultural products from the rural to the urban such as chickpeas, oil seeds, eggs and take it to the town. And from the town she traded industrial products such as coffee, edible oil, kerosene, sugar and coffee which are not found in the rural market in the area. He said his mother was making good return from her business and supported him to cover education materials when he was in his preparatory level as well as in his years of study in the university. He added that the support had multifaceted importance because it has motivated the family to start petty business and generate income as well as supported him to cover*

his expenses in the university. He said that he had no one to turn to for support. He said his elder brother quitted school at grade 9th due to lack of support from his parents and went to commercial farm areas to look for employment. Bamlaku said "I am very thankful for the support extended to me as the result of the scholarship program which enabled me to achieve my career path which otherwise would have the same fate of my elder brother".

7. Results of the program

The core result of the program is to enable students to continue their education in the higher level. In the previous years the program has been successful to continue their education at a higher level and most of them have successfully completed their preparatory level, joined the university, graduated and serving the nation in different capacities. In the reporting year most students have passed the national exam and enrolled in the different universities in the country. In South Gonder zone alone out of 53 students who sat for the National Exam and were getting the scholarship support from GRRDA/GDCO 46 have passed the exam (-86.6.6%) and are placed in the different universities in the country. The report from N. Gonder zone could not be obtained due to the new zones distribution.

8. Challenges

The project implementation is not without a challenge. The following are the core challenges identified during the reporting period:

- Communication: Schools and zone education offices could not submit students' data in time which is a challenge to compile information of students.
- Some areas do not have banks and posed a challenge to transfer the grant in time.
- So far it has become a challenge to track scholarship awardees to participate in GRRDA's activities as a way of succession.
- As new preparatory schools are established by the government, the number of preparatory schools requesting to be included in the program is increasing and creating complaints. In 2019 there were 40 preparatory schools in North Gonder and 24 in S. Gonder. The program is covering to date 45 in the two schools.
- Follow up and monitoring of the project implementation is a challenge due to the spread of the schools and budget constraint for such purposes.

9. Conclusion

In 2018/2019 the scholarship project was implemented successfully addressing 249 students which accounts 92.2% of the planned targets; while the financial performance was Birr 498,000 which accounted 92.2% of the annual budget. Moreover, the program has supported 259 university students with an outlay of Birr 337,500 from first year to third year.

In the reporting year GRRDA has embarked in other activities related to emergency cases. Due to the conflict between 'Qemant and Amhara' tens of thousands of people were displaced. GRRDA mobilized Birr 262,000 from members and supporters and donated to the Central Disaster Risk Prevention and Food Security Department to complement the efforts of the zone so that it builds leverage. Birr 50,000 was donated to families displaced in the various regions of the country and sheltered in Dere Tabor town which supported the food needs of 154 people for two months.

Moreover, GRRDA has applied to International Rescue Committee (IRC) an international NGO for fund and implemented a Water and Sanitation project which benefited 22,000 people.
